



The Father's Blessing

The Lord Bless You. The key here is that this is GOD'S blessing. Your Heavenly Father, your Papa, loves you more than your mind can comprehend. He wants you to experience something to the depths of your soul and receive a "favor" you can carry through life.

And Keep You. David assures us that God will "give His angels charge over you, to keep you in all your ways" (Psa. 91:11). From the New Testament: "Now to Him Who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to present you faultless before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy" (Jude 24-25).

The Lord Make His Face Shine Upon You. What or Who do you see when you look up? YOU are pleasing to your Father. "He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing" (Zeph. 3:17). God is always happy with Jesus and that is Who He sees when He looks at you.

And Be Gracious to You. When approaching God, aren't you glad you come to a "Throne of Grace" instead of the bench of justice? Justice was served when Jesus paid for your sins. His invitation is-

"come boldly to the throne of grace that you might find mercy and obtain grace" (Heb. 4:16). It's a new day!

The Lord Lift Up His Countenance Upon You. Joy is God's countenance. He is joyful because He sees all things complete in Jesus. And He wants His joy to be our joy. Life is tough. Allowing His countenance to envelop you is like a refreshing mist on a hot day. Receive your Father's blessing.

And Give You Peace. "Shalom" (peace) which Jewish people speak to one another is more than peace. It means well being, contentment, friendship, security, harmony with God. All of this comes with the Father's Blessing. He wants to give you His blessing right now. Let Him speak this to you: *"My child, I bless you. You are Mine. I will keep you today and everyday. My face is shining on you this moment and My grace, My unmerited favor is yours. I am lifting up My countenance upon you, let My joy push away your sorrows and completely overwhelm you. Be at peace. You are safe in My arms."*

"I would appreciate your prayers for my trip to India tomorrow. The tasks are very daunting, but I know God is in control.


